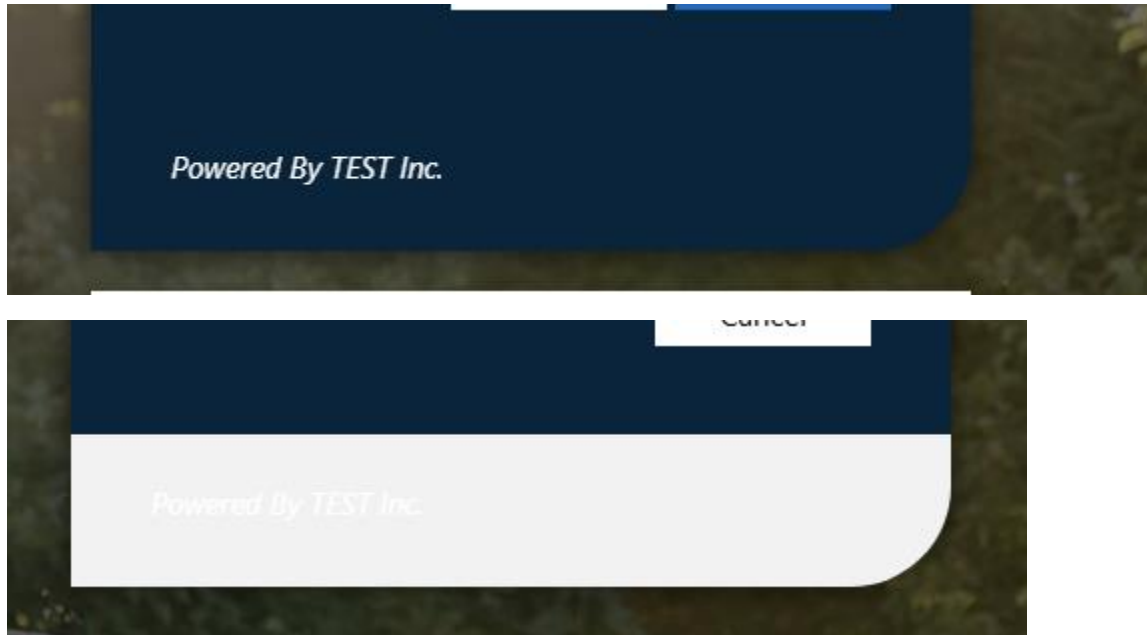

.ext-boilerplate-text - doesn't continue to the subsequent page to confirm sustained sign in so the colour doesn't persist

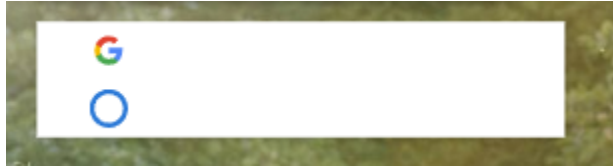


.ext-input.ext-text-box – I am trying to update the colour of the placeholder to white because its base is some blue

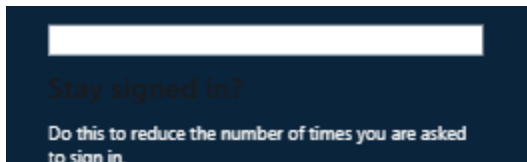
